1. INTRODUCTION

Ecofy Finance Private Limited (formerly known as Accretive Cleantech Finance Pvt Ltd) ("Ecofy") is an NBFC (Non-Banking Financial Company) providing financial assistance to buyers of various electric vehicles (Two-wheelers & Three-wheelers), Rooftop Solar, SME Loans, amongst others.

2. PURPOSE

The following Privacy Policy (hereinafter referred to as privacy policy, privacy notice, privacy statement or policy) describes how we ("Data Fiduciary") collect, use, and disclose information and what choices you ("User", "Data Principal") have with respect to the information. Ecofy is the controller for the personal data discussed in this Privacy Statement, except as noted in the "Ecofy as a Service Provider" section below. This Policy serves as a testament to our unwavering commitment to safeguarding the rights of Data Principal, including employees, aligning rigorously with the Digital Personal Data Protection Act("DPDPA"), 2023.

3. <u>SCOPE</u>

This privacy policy applies to all our employees, prospective employees, and customers, as well as other users and website visitors. This Privacy Notice also applies to our prospective customers who visit the website to understand the services provided by us.

For the purposes of this notice, a "visitor" of Ecofy refers to an individual who accesses Ecofy's website with or without registering for an account or who provides personal data to Ecofy, for various purposes, as given in Para 6.

Ecofy is responsible for safeguarding the privacy of the data provided by users through its own channels. However, third-party service providers that Ecofy may engage with are responsible for collecting data from various sources, including Ecofy's channels. These third-party providers may collect data either with or without Ecofy's direct consent, depending on the specific arrangement or legal requirements associated with each service."

4. DATA PROTECTION PRINCIPLES

The following key principles are enshrined in the applicable Laws and are fundamental to Ecofy's Policy. In its capacity as a Data Controller, Ecofy ensures that all activities shall abide by the following principles:

- **4.1** Processing shall be performed lawfully, fairly and in a transparent manner.
- **4.2** Personal Data shall be collected for specified and explicit purposes and not further processed in a manner that is incompatible with those purposes; further Processing for any other purposes is permissible if they are similar or relevant to the purposes for which such data are originally collected.
- **4.3** Personal Data shall be adequate and limited to what is necessary in relation to the purposes for which they are processed;
- 4.4 Personal Data shall be accurate and, where necessary, kept up to date;
- **4.5** Every reasonable step must be taken to ensure that Personal Data that are inaccurate are erased or rectified;
- **4.6** Personal Data shall be kept in a manner that ensures appropriate security of the Personal Data, including protection against any infringement, breach or unauthorised or unlawful processing, using appropriate technical or organisational measures by the applicable laws in this regard;
- **4.7** Personal Data shall not be kept after the completion of the purpose for which such data is processed, provided that such data may be further kept if its Data Subject can no longer be identifiable using the "anonymization" technique.

5. HOW AND WHEN DATA COLLECTION HAPPENS

We collect and process Personal Data when the Data Principal:

- **5.1** Visit our website and provide us with their details to get in touch or contact us with our team and leave a message.
- **5.2** If the Data Principals are using our platform, the information is required at their end; or through our branded pages on third-party sites.
- 5.3 Provide any information to fulfil the contractual (employment) obligation.
- 5.4 Sign up to receive updates from us via email or media channels.
- 5.5 Use a mobile device or web browser to access our content.
- **5.6** Offline interacts with us via hardcopy application forms or contact us via email, social media, or any similar technologies.

6. DATA COLLECTION

We collect the following category of information:

- 6.1 Full Name
- 6.2 Address
- 6.3 Email-address
- 6.4 Date of Birth

- 6.5 Gender
- 6.6 Employment Information
- 6.7 Masked Aadhaar
- 6.8 Driving License
- 6.9 Bank Account Details
- 6.10 Phone Number
- 6.11 City/State

We may also collect personal data, namely bank statements, financial information, KYC details, and security details.

7. WITHDRAWAL OF CONSENT

If after consenting to share your Personal Information, you wish to withdraw/revoke your consent for the already shared Personal Information, you may contact us at **support@ecofy.co.in**, and we will return/destroy your Personal Information if obtained.

8. HOW DO WE USE YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION

- 8.1 We collect your Personal Information with the primary goal of providing you with a smooth, efficient, and customised experience. The information enables us to provide services and features that are most likely to meet your needs and make your experience smoother.
- **8.2** We shall exclusively employ your Personal Data for the designated intentions for which it was acquired unless we reasonably determine that there exists a need to employ it for an alternative rationale that aligns with the original purpose. In the event that we necessitate the utilization of your Personal Data for an unconnected objective, we shall duly inform you and elucidate the legal foundation that permits us to proceed accordingly.
- **8.3** Except where specifically agreed or necessary for operational or regulatory reasons, we will not send you any unsolicited information. However, to help you take full advantage of the service offerings of the Company, you will have the opportunity to indicate whether you would like to "opt-out" of receiving promotional and/or marketing information about other products, services and offerings from our and/or any third parties etc. If the user does not opt out, we may use any email addresses of users to send occasional emails pertaining to the said information. The user can nevertheless unsubscribe from receipt of such emails by following instructions therein or by communicating accordingly to us.
- **8.4** We may process your Personal Data without your knowledge or consent, in compliance with the above rules, wherever required or permitted by law.

9. LEGAL BASIS FOR PROCESSING YOUR PERSONAL DATA

We process Personal Data based on one or more of the following processing conditions:

- **9.1 Contractual Necessity:** Personal Data may be processed when it is essential to fulfil a contractual obligation with the Data Subject.
- **9.2 Legitimate Interest of the Business**: Data processing may occur when it serves the legitimate interests of Ecofy, provided that such interests are not overridden by the rights and freedoms of the Data Principals.
- **9.3 Vital Interest of Data Subject:** In situations where it is crucial to protect the vital interests of the Data Subject or another person, Personal Data may be processed.
- **9.4 Legal Obligation:** Personal Data may be processed to comply with legal obligations to which Ecofy is subject.

10. RIGHTS OF DATA PRINCIPAL

Data principal have certain rights under the data protection laws in relation to the personal data held by us. In, particular the Data Principal may have the following rights:

- 10.1 Right to access information about personal data
- **10.2** Right to correction and erasure of personal data.
- **10.3** Right of grievance redressal.
- **10.4** Right to nominate.
- **10.5** Right to opt-in/opt-out for some cookie categories
- **10.6** View list of cookies generated by the website under each category
- 10.7 Access the website even if you opt-out of all cookies

11. DATA STORAGE AND RETENTION

We maintain reasonable administrative, technical, and physical safeguards to protect Personal Data against accidental or unlawful destruction, loss, alteration, unauthorized disclosure, or access. We retain Personal Data for as long as necessary for the purposes for which it was collected. The retention period for different types of data is defined based on the applicable legal and business requirements.

12. SHARING PERSONAL INFORMATION OF USER/S

We do not sell, trade, or rent User's personal identification information to others. We may share generic aggregated demographic information not linked to any personal identification information regarding User/s with our subsidiaries, our business partners, trusted affiliates, and advertisers for the purpose of providing you with the relevant services and personalised experience. We may further do so if we are required by a Court Order, Government Authorities, Law Enforcement Authorities; Credit Information Companies or other legal processes or by any other statutory body or where it becomes necessary to do so to protect our rights or property in order to establish, exercise or defend its legal rights.

13. SECURITY MEASURES

13.1 We use appropriate security measures to protect your data against unauthorised access, alteration, disclosure or destruction. We maintain physical, electronic, and procedural safeguards in connection with the collection, storage, and disclosure of customer personal information. Our security procedures mean that we may ask to verify your identity before we disclose personal information to you. All data exchanges between the sites and their users happen over an SSL-secured communication channel, which is encrypted and protected with digital signatures. While we take utmost measures to protect the data, you acknowledge that there is no "perfect security" on the internet. A list of third parties having customer access is available on the website. We use the help of Internet Protocol ("IP") addresses to diagnose any problems with its server and to administer its website including blocking certain addresses that it feels are inappropriately using its website. IP addresses are used to gather broad demographic information, such as browser types, visitor's country, visiting frequency, operating systems, etc.

14. CONTACT US

Every Data Principal has the right to access their personal data, that is stored by the Data Fiduciary. A Data Principal can make a Data Subject Request (DSR), for the same.

1. INTRODUCTION

This is the cookie policy of Ecofy Finance Private Limited (formerly known as Accretive Cleantech Finance Pvt Ltd,) organized and existing under the applicable laws of India having its principal place of business at Lvl-12, Birla Aurora, Dr. Annie Besant Rd, Worli, Mumbai-400050 ("Ecofy", "we", or "us"). By using our website, (ecofy.co.in) (our "Website"), and selecting the

appropriate preferences, you consent to our use of cookies, IP addresses and our use of other methods to collect website usage data as detailed in this Policy ("Cookie Policy"). Please read this Cookie Policy together with the Privacy Policy posted on our website.

This Cookie Policy explains how Ecofy uses cookies and similar tracking technologies when you use our website and services. By using our website and services, you consent to the use of cookies and tracking technologies as described in this Policy. When you visit our website for the first time, you will be asked to give consent or reject the collection and use of cookies and similar tracking technologies.

2. WHAT ARE COOKIES

Cookies are small data files stored on your computer or other devices when you visit a website using a browser. They are commonly used to remember your preferences and activity, either for a single session ("session cookies") or across multiple visits ("functional cookies"). Cookies help ensure a smooth and consistent user experience and enable key functions like account registration and staying logged in.

Cookies can be set by the website you visit ("first-party cookies") or by external providers offering services such as analytics, advertising, or content delivery ("third-party cookies"). Websites and HTML emails may also use tracking tools like "web beacons" or "pixels," which are small, transparent images designed to gather statistical data on user behaviour. These tools often work alongside cookies for similar purposes, but unlike cookies, they are not stored on your device. Disabling cookies may limit the functionality of these tracking tools, although

they may still load.

3. USE OF COOKIES AND SIMILAR TECHNOLOGIES

We use cookies for several different purposes -

4. TYPES OF COOKIES WE USE

We use both first-party and third-party cookies on our website.

First-party cookies are cookies issued from the domain that are generally used to identify language and location preferences or render basic site functionality.

Third-party cookies belong to and are managed by other parties, such as Ecofy business partners or service providers. These cookies may be required to render certain forms, such as the submission of forms, or to allow for some advertising outside of the Ecofy website.

4.1. Session Cookies

We use session cookies to keep you logged in during your session and persistent cookies to remember your preferences and settings across visits. These cookies are typically retained until they are necessary.

4.2. Essential Cookies

These cookies, often referred to as strictly necessary cookies, play a fundamental role in enabling websites to deliver essential functions and access key features. By allowing us to remember your preferences and deliver relevant content in a secure environment, they underpin core website functionality, including vital features like login authentication and user management. While essential cookies are crucial for seamless operation and accessibility, most browsers do not allow users to disable them through browser preferences due to their necessity for basic website functionality.

4.3. Functional Cookies

These cookies allow a site to remember choices you make (such as your username, language, or region) and provide enhanced, personalized features. They allow remembering information and user preferences such as login data, region, language, and enhanced content but do not track browsing activity across other websites. 4.4. Performance Cookies
